He left (ran away) from Egypt when he was 40 and lived in Midian to the east where he married and worked as a shepherd for his father in law. Moses himself never entered it, but he died at 120, just before they finally entered the land under the leadership of his disciple, Joshua.

We don't know for sure when Job lived. But none of his friends quoted anything from the Law, so we presume it was before the Exodus (1446BC).
